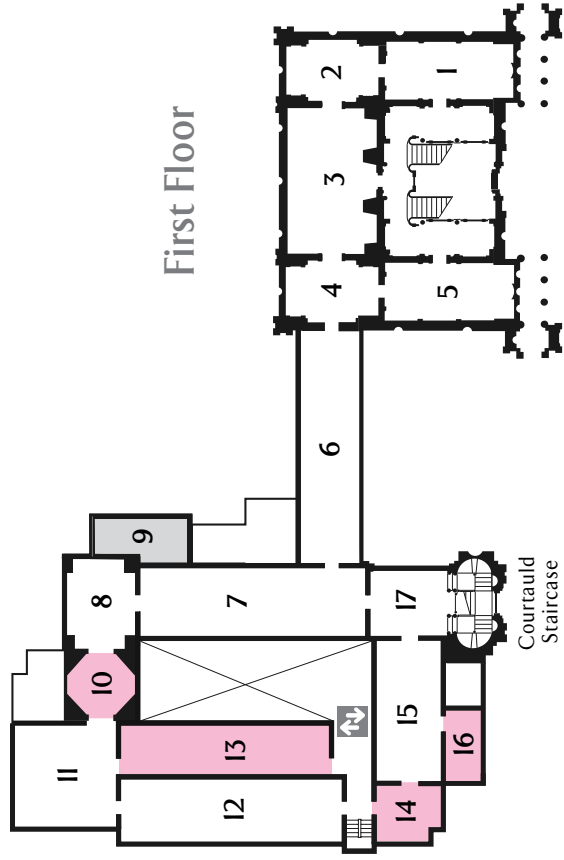
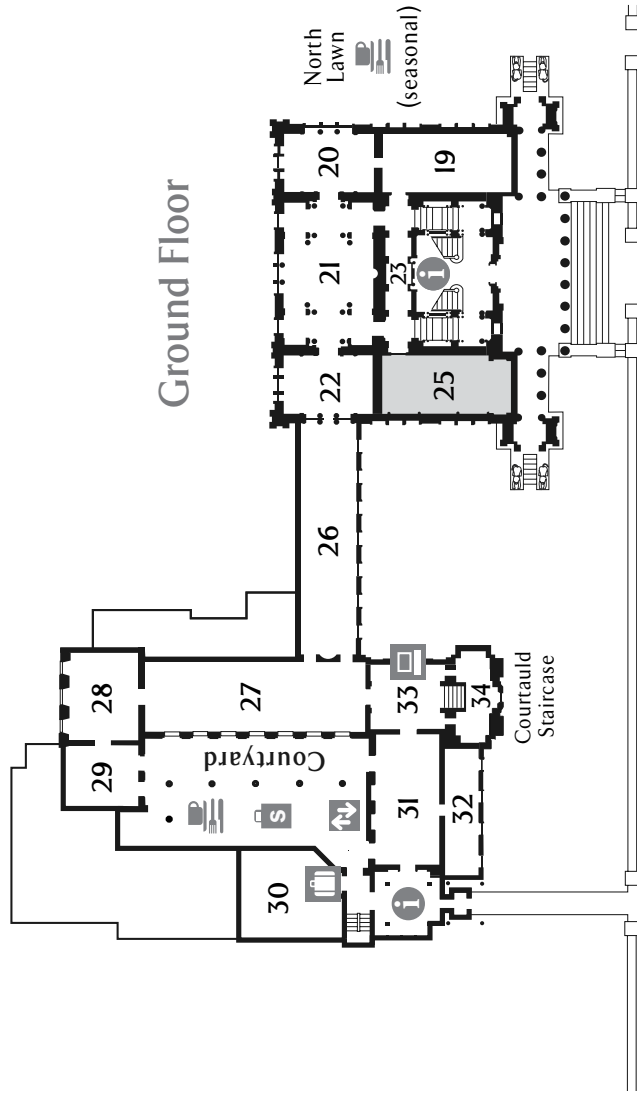

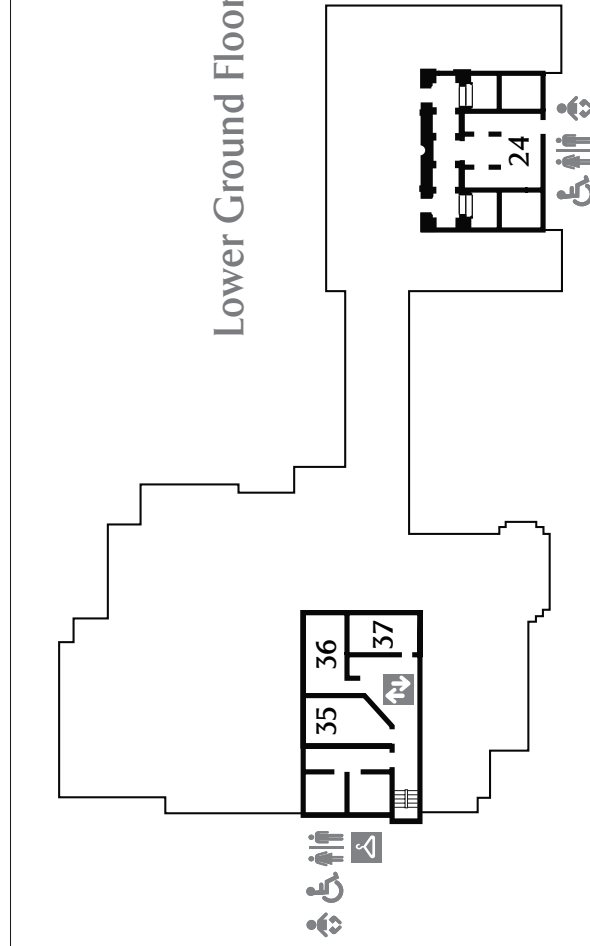

Welcome to The Fitzwilliam Museum

This leaflet provides information to help you make the most of your visit. If there is anything else you need to know, or in the event of an emergency, please ask a member of staff for assistance.

Admission is free Visitors are invited to make donations which help keep the galleries open and are much appreciated.

Galleries are on the ground and first floors.

Seminar room, studio and schools cloakroom and lunchroom are on the lower ground floor.

Lift to all floors is located near the Courtyard Entrance.

Wheelchairs are available at the Courtyard Entrance for visitors' use.

Cloakrooms with bag checks and secure coat racks are located at both entrances.

WCs and baby-changing facilities are located near both entrances and close 15 minutes before the Museum.

Reference Library Visitors are welcome to use the Museum's Reference Library in Room 30 near the Courtyard Entrance. Open Tuesday to Friday 10.00-16.30.

The Courtyard Café serves an all-day menu including morning coffee, afternoon tea, sandwiches and light lunches. **The North Lawn Café** serves refreshments in an *al fresco* setting from March to October, weather permitting. Cafés close 30 minutes before the Museum.

The Courtyard Shop adjacent to the Café sells a wide range of postcards, greetings cards, art books, jewellery and giftware inspired by the collections. Shop closes 15 minutes before the Museum.

Exhibitions and Events *What's On* leaflet gives details of the Museum's exhibitions and events programme.

eGuide An Audio-visual guide on hand-held computer with touch screen is available at the Main Entrance. This provides an interactive tour of highlights of the Museum's collections. Please return 30 minutes before Museum closes.

Fitzwilliam Online Access to the Museum's online catalogue OPAC and to Pharos – a rich web resource connecting objects in the collections and providing information on their context and creation – is available via terminals in Room 33 near the Courtyard Entrance.
