Dear Bean,

I am deeply ashamed of myself for letting your letter of 25 Feb. lie so long. You'll have seen the completed map - I hope your section is to your taste. May George has made a very pretty job of it.

I have no views on the Via Sebaste S. W. of Antioch, never having seen the country. I shall if you will publish a note on the new evidence.

The stone with Zeus Μένειος, the seated woman & Hermes must surely be a close parallel to ^{MAMA} Vol VIII, no 1, now in the press, from Kavak on the territory of Lystra - 'Ερε[ό]δω[ρο]ς καὶ οἱ αὐτοῦ σ[ύ]γγε[νοι] [εἰς] [Ἐπὶ]κ[ό]ω κα[ὶ] [Γῆ] [καὶ] Ἐρεῖ εὐχ[ή]ν.

Here I take Ἐπὶκ[ό]ω to be = Zeus.

Γῆ occurs in a second dedication at Kavak, and is preferable to Διί, which would duplicate

Ετήκοος. Remember that at Lystra Paul
& Barnabas were taken for Hermes & Zeus.
Z. & H. were already known in association near
Lystra C.R. XXIV p. 77 & Svoroboda Keil
Knoll Denkmäler p. 72. I know no other
instance of the Scription for being recorded.
Robert may know, but...

I like your explanation of Tysson.
It must be right. Thanks for the
article.
