Discover in a day Arts Award: Make art inspired by India and get your Discover level Arts Award today.

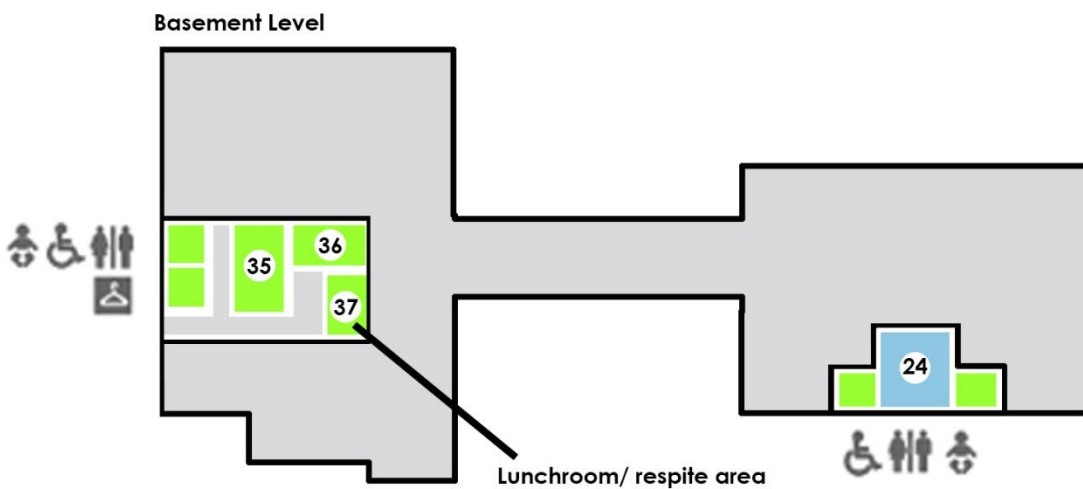
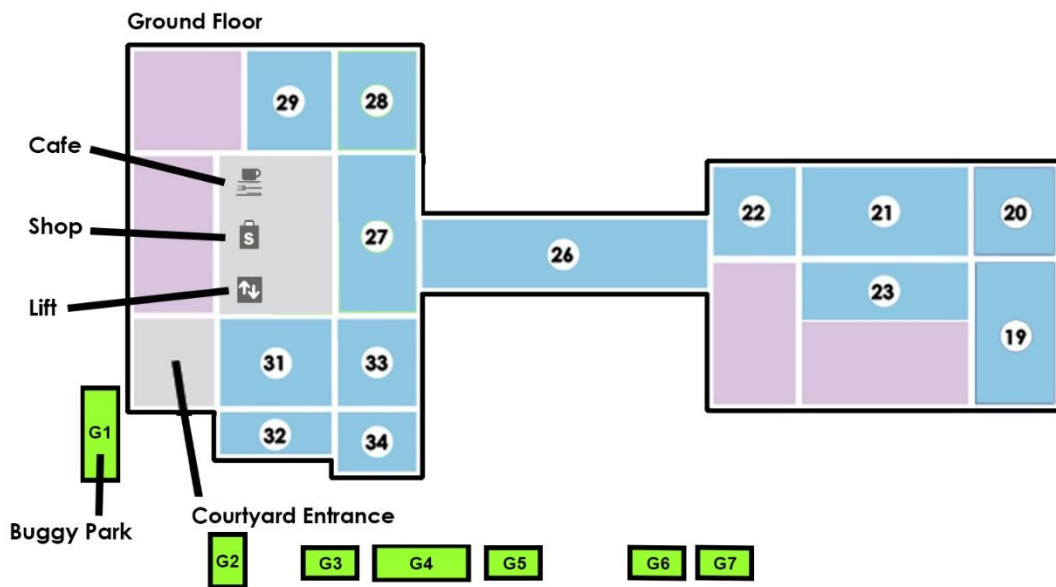
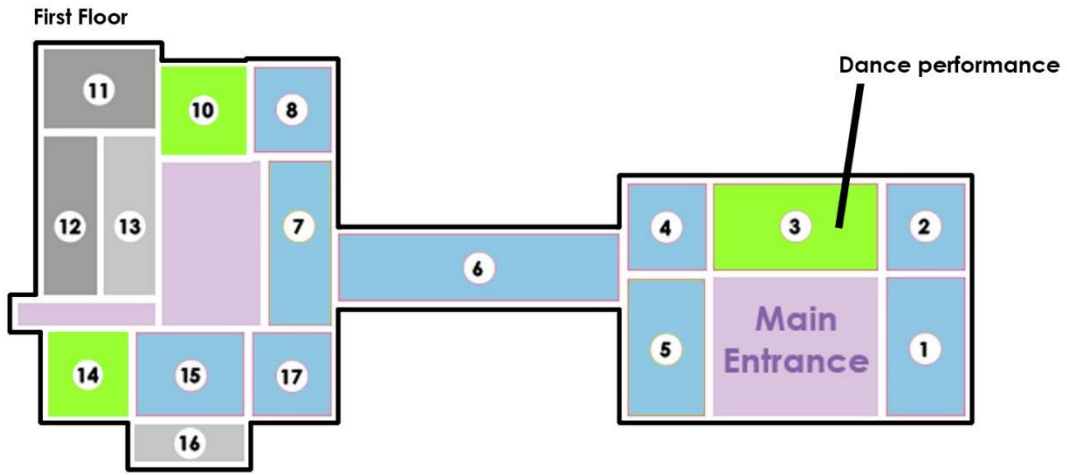
Art activity: Search for animals in the *From Kabul to Kolkata* exhibition (Gallery 14) then use what you have found to make your own Indian animal mask
